What are Chrismons?

The meaning of Chrismons is "Christ monograms." They are traditionally white and gold designs made from Christian symbols that signify Christ. Chrismons are often displayed on an evergreen tree during the Advent season. Symbols such as stars, crosses, fish, crowns, and the alpha and omega remind us of Christ's identity, his story, and of the Holy Trinity.
